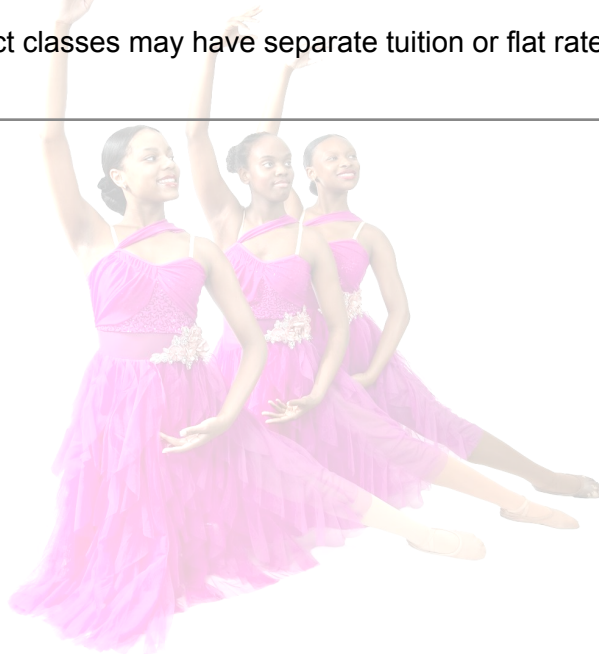

5+ CLASSES PER WEEK FOR COMPANY MEMBERS

Company members enrolled in five or more weekly classes may qualify for an individualized tuition package based on their schedule and total weekly required training hours.

Specialty, intensive, and select classes may have separate tuition or flat rates.



REGISTRATION FEE

Annual Registration Fee: \$75 per dancer

A maximum registration fee of **\$150 per family** will apply to families enrolling multiple dancers.

The registration fee is due at the time of enrollment and is **non-refundable**.

Registration fees help support the administrative and operational costs associated with student enrollment, class placement, communication, scheduling, and preparation for the upcoming dance season.

TUITION PAYMENT POLICY

Monthly tuition is due on the **1st of each month**.

Tuition payments are processed through the studio's designated payment system.

A late fee of **\$25.00** may be assessed to accounts with unpaid tuition after the **10th of the month**. Daily late fees of **\$10.00** will be additional if unpaid tuition carries past the **20th of the month**.

Students with significantly past-due accounts may be subject to restrictions on class participation until the account is brought current.

Tuition is based on the student's reserved space in class and is not adjusted for individual absences, missed classes, vacations, or personal scheduling conflicts.

CLASS WITHDRAWAL POLICY

To withdraw from a class, families must provide **at least three weeks' written notice**.

Until written notice is received and the withdrawal has been processed, the student will remain enrolled, and tuition will continue to be due.

Verbal notification to an instructor does not constitute official withdrawal from a class.

PERFORMANCE & PRODUCTION FEES

Performance opportunities are an important part of the SQAD experience. These fees help cover the extensive costs associated with costumes, production preparation, venue expenses, staging, technical elements, and other performance-related needs.

WINTER PRODUCTION FEE

\$425 per participating dancer or \$455 per multi- family

The Winter Production Fee may include costs associated with:

- Performance costume
- Production preparation
- Performance-related administrative expenses
- Production materials and related expenses

Additional costs may apply depending on the production and costume requirements.

Headshot Fee & Photo Day Studio Fee

- \$25 per dancer (non-refundable)
- Covers photography set-up, production, and staffing.
- Will be debited on Studio Director Winter Performance
- Required for all enrolled students (unless religious conflict). Must be communicated upon registration.
- Includes 1 complimentary ticket.
- ½ Due October 1st with Tuition. Second ½ Due November 1st with Tuition.
- Students must provide personal shoes, tights, undergarments, hair accessories, and makeup.

SPRING RECITAL FEE

\$150 per dancer

\$175 family maximum

The Spring Recital Fee helps support the costs associated with producing SQUAD's annual spring performance, including performance preparation, production materials, and recital-related expenses.

COSTUME FEES

Costume fees vary based on the class, age group, costume design, and production requirements.

Estimated costume fee ranges include:

- **Creative Q / Creative Q Tots:** \$95-\$190
- **Petite Classes:** \$95-\$380
- **Tumbling/Theatric Classes:** \$95-\$190
- **Leveled Classes:** \$95-\$570
- **Specialty or Complex Costumes:** Up to \$300

Costume fees are **non-refundable once costumes have been ordered**. Unpaid costume fees will result in the dancer not having a costume for recital pictures. Late payments may incur additional shipping costs and delay the time to place the order after it has already been ordered.

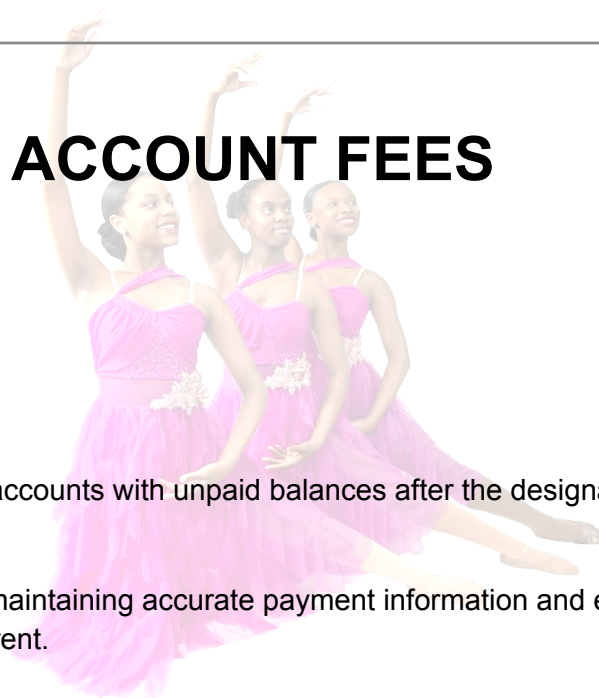

Participation in performances, productions, workshops, and specialty programs may require additional fees.

SQAD reserves the right to update tuition, fees, schedules, and policies as needed to support the continued growth and operation of the academy.
